INS Viraat was an integral part of the Indian Navy

New Delhi, India, Feb 15, 2017 -- After a service life of 57 years, including over three decades for India, aircraft carrier INS Viraat will be given a ceremonial farewell on March 6. A befitting ceremony is planned for the occasion with "whose who" in the Navy and a large number of delegates from number of countries on the invitation list, sources in the Navy told UNI. "At the sunset, Navy's flag will be lowered and


wrapped, bringing curtains down on the illustrious journey of the aircraft carrier," said the sources. The aircraft carrier remained in service for over five and half decades -- first as HMS Hermes in the Royal British Navy and in its present avatar with the Indian Navy since 1987. Viraat saw action in the Falklands War and remained for well over a decade the sole aircraft carrier in the Indian Ocean region following the decommissioning of the first Indian carrier INS Vikrant in 1997. The Carrier holds the Guinness Record for being the oldest serving warship. The Aircraft Carrier was towed back to Mumbai on completion of its last Essential Repairs and Dry Docking (ERDD) at the Cochin Shipyard. INS Viraat was commissioned into the Indian Navy on May 12 1987. The ship operated Sea Harrier (White Tigers - fighter aircrafts), Seaking 42B (Harpoons - Anti Submarine helicopters) and Seaking 42C (Commando Carrier helicopters) and Chetak (Angles - SAR helicopter).
